Minutes of Meeting of September 13, 2017

The Chairman asked the Committee members to approve the minutes of the Governance and Compensation Committee meeting held on September 13, 2017, in the form previously provided to the Committee. On motion made and seconded, the minutes of the September 13, 2017 meeting were unanimously approved as previously provided.

Mission Statement and Performance Goals

Mr. Cole reported that the Public Authorities Law requires an annual review of the Corporation's Mission Statement and Performance Goals (together, the "Mission Statement"). He advised that the Governance and Compensation Committee reviews the Mission Statement each year before it is presented to the Corporation's Board of Directors for approval. Mr. Cole reported that management did not recommend any changes to the current Mission Statement.
